## Early Years Foundation Stage Framework Specific Areas

### Literacy

We will learn the story of 'The Little Red Hen' with actions. We will innovate it, changing the animals she asks help from. We will then learn and recite some instructions on 'How to Make Bread' and then make some! We will continue to invent 5-sentence stories.

### Mathematics

We will further develop subitising and counting skills. We will explore the composition of numbers within 5. We will begin to compare sets of objects and use our language of comparison. We will look at circles, triangles and shapes with 4 sides.

### Past and Present

We will use words related to past and present when investigating 'what do roadworkers use to melt ice?'. We will do this when comparing the effects different substances have on ice. We will also talk about our own family traditions during Christmas time, talking about our own lived experiences.

### People, Culture and Communities

We will visit and interact with people and places within our own community: Herbie's café, the library, the church, and the SpArC. We will talk to nurses and the fire service. We will learn why we hold Remembrance Day and Bonfire Night. We will learn why Christmas is important for Christians.

### The Natural World

We will continue to observe how the natural world changes from Autumn to Winter through playing and exploring outdoors regularly. We will do some fieldwork in our town exploring the question: 'do we have enough shops?'

### Creating with Materials

We will create artwork linked with Remembrance day and Bonfire night. We will invite local artist Nicola Knapton in and have a go at felting a piece of Christmas art. We will bake Little Red Hen's bread.

### Being Imaginative and Expressive

We will role play people in our community who help us, including using our role play area the Post Office.
