As Mathematicians, we will focus on multiplication & division . We will practise our X–Tables every day. *X-Table quiz on a Friday afternoon (practise on TTRs at home)*

As Scientists, we will be exploring electricity and living things & habitats through investigations and experiments.

In Computing, we will study media.

As Historians, our topic will be Achievements & Legacies.

As designers, we will be learning all about dips. We will plan and make our own dips.

In R.E., we will focus on Understanding Christianity, asking the question: What does it mean if God is holy and loving?

In PSHE (Jigsaw), our unit will be 'Celebrating Difference' where we think about our identity, goals, and role in the community.
