



School Uniform

Uniform is worn to develop a sense of pride in being a member of our school community. Wearing uniform contributes to the positive ethos of the school, encouraging good behaviour and good learning. Our uniform consists of the following:

GIRLS

- Grey skirt, pinafore or well-tailored trousers or shorts
- White or navy polo shirt
- School sweatshirt or plain navy cardigan/jumper

Optional in Summer:

- Blue and white checked or striped dress

BOYS

- Well-tailored grey trousers or shorts
- White or navy polo shirt
- School sweatshirt or plain navy jumper

Sensible black school shoes should be worn – no trainers. In summer, **robust** sandals may be worn.

Each child must also have a PE kit, comprising pumps/trainers, t-shirt, shorts and, where possible, jogging trousers. PE kit should be available in school at all times and kept in a named bag suitable for hanging on a coat peg.

PE kit should consist of a plain white, black or blue t-shirt and a plain grey, black or blue jumper and plain grey, black or blue shorts/jogging bottoms. No big logos or bright coloured clothing.

School uniform sweatshirts and polo shirts are available to purchase from the school office.

Sweatshirts cost £8.40

Cardigans cost £9.60

Polo shirts cost £7.00

All clothing should be clearly named.

Apart from small studs for pierced ears, which must be removed for PE and swimming, no jewellery is allowed in school.

Long hair should be tied up and make-up and nail varnish should not be worn.

As children start school, they will be provided with a book bag and water bottle.

Replacement school book bags and water bottles are also available from the school office.

Book bags cost £3.60 each and water bottles £1.10.
