National Curriculum

As Readers, we will be continuing with Journey to Jo'burg by Beverley Naidoo as our class text. Children should be reading every day at home.

In Spelling, we will be using Spelling Shed Stage 4 to develop our spelling knowledge and accuracy. Spelling quizzes are on a Friday afternoon (children will have their words for a week).

As Writers, we will be focusing on a Warning Tale – The Red Eye and learning about writing with persuasion through The Wizard of Wozardy.

In Poetry, we will enjoy reading, performing, and writing a range of poems.

As Mathematicians, we will continue developing our knowledge of fractions and explore decimals, measurement, and statistics. We will practise our times tables every day, with a quiz on Fridays (remember to practise on TTRS at home).

As Scientists, we will be investigating sound – exploring how sounds are made, how they travel, and how they can be changed.

In Computing, we will be learning about data and information, including data logging.

As Historians and Geographers, our topic will be Ancient Egypt: Trade and Transport, where we will discover how Egyptians used the River Nile and traded goods.

As Designers, we will be exploring Shell Structures and Food Packaging, planning and creating our own packaging designs.

In R.E., we will continue with Understanding Christianity, focusing on the question: What did Jesus do to save human beings?

In PSHE (Jigsaw), our unit is Healthy Me, where we will think about how to keep our bodies and minds healthy.

In P.E., we will be developing our skills in swimming.

As Musicians, we will follow the Music Express unit Keeping Healthy, exploring rhythm, movement, and musical performance.

In French, we will be learning about La Famille and practising conversations about family members.
