As Mathematicians,

Year 2s will begin by securing their measurement knowledge with length and height. They will then move onto mass, capacity and temperature. Year 3s will begin by securing their number knowledge with fractions. They will then move onto measurement with mass and capacity.

As Scientists, we will be exploring the world of physics looking at light and seeing.
